How to create your child's own MonsterWalk fundraising page

- Go to https://give.classy.org/MonsterWalk24
- Click on "Become a Fundraiser."
- Select to search for your child's teacher.
- You can log in if you already have an account from last year or create one if you don't. (Please note the site now allows you to set up multiple pages with a single email address.)
- If you're setting up a new account, enter your email and choose a password, or sign in with Facebook and click "Next."
- Once logged in, you will begin to create your page. The fundraising goal is auto populated for you, but you can increase it if you'd like.
- You can set your page's headline. It can be anything! Many will opt for [Student's Name]'s School Walkathon!
- Set your page's url. This is an optional step but it can make it easier for contributors to find your page. Examples are "Bobby's Big Walk" or "Susie Walks for School." It can be any brief title you want in the short url field. The donation link you send to others will then be https:give.classy.org/BobbysBigWalk. Now click "Finish."
- Choose a photo (optional).
- Your page's story is already populated, but feel free to personalize it if you wish by clicking "MANAGE" under your child's name and edit it.
- Send the link to family and friends. You can text the link, send it via email and post it to your social media channels as well. Families often make videos of their children talking about MonsterWalk and asking loved ones to support their school, or have them write emails/letters themselves. Whatever you do, get your kids involved! It's how they know what they're walking for.
